



## Farmersville Unified School District Transportation Plan 2022-23 & 2023-24

### Transportation Services:

Farmersville Unified School District has 11 buses servicing the transportation needs of six schools. The department provides free transportation services for all students for activity trips throughout the central valley and Farmersville City that support the educational activities of the schools Pre-Kindergarten through 12 grades, including curricular, extra-curricular and athletic trips for students. The district also works with outside transportation agencies to provide transportation for all of our students.

Farmersville Unified School District offers transportation services in the least restrictive environment to all homeless students, foster youth and pupils with disabilities that meet the criteria for severely disabled and/or non-ambulatory. If there is no space available on existing district buses, or the distance does not allow reasonable service, the district allows free bus passes for homeless and foster youth.

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### Consultations:

Farmersville Unified School District has community forums to provide information to classified staff, teachers, school administrators, regional local transit authorities, local air pollution control districts and air quality management districts, parents, pupils and other stakeholders.
