## **Transportation Services:**

Farmersville Unified School District has 11 buses Servicing the transportation needs of six schools. The department provides free transportation services for all students for activity trips through-out the central valley and Farmersville City that support the educational activities of the schools Pre-Kindergarden through 12 grades, including curricular, extra- curricular and athletic trips for students. The district also works with outside transportation agencies to provide transportation for all of our students.

If there is no space available on existing district buses, or the distance does not allow reasonable service, the district allows free bus passes for homless and foster youth.
