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What is a Dual Language Immersion Program?

The Farmersville Unified School District, Dual Language Immersion Program integrates English Proficiency and English learner students for the purpose of developing bilingualism, bi-literacy, and cultural competence.

Instruction in Kindergarten is delivered 90% of the day in Spanish and 10% of the day in English. There is a gradual decrease of specifically designed Spanish instruction until 50% of the day is spent in each language. In high school, students participate in AP Spanish language and Literature with the end goal of students graduating fully bi-literate and will receive the Seal of Bi-literacy.

Goals:

- ✓ Proficiency in reading, writing, speaking, and listening in Spanish & English
- ✓ High academic achievement in Spanish & English
- ✓ Higher levels of divergent thinking, pattern recognition, & problem solving
- ✓ Positive self-esteem, cultural awareness & sensitivity.

Who is eligible:

- ✓ All FUSD Kindergarten students are eligible
- ✓ Priority enrollment for siblings
- ✓ Commit to the program goals through 6th Grade
- ✓ If child is placed on waitlist, parents will be notified about available spots.
- ✓ Families outside of FUSD must request a release from their home district and application completed.
