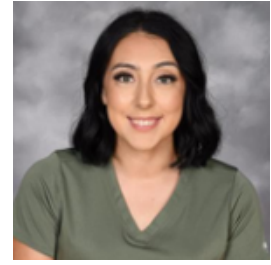

Social Skills: Students will learn and apply skills that will enhance their socialization with peers and staff

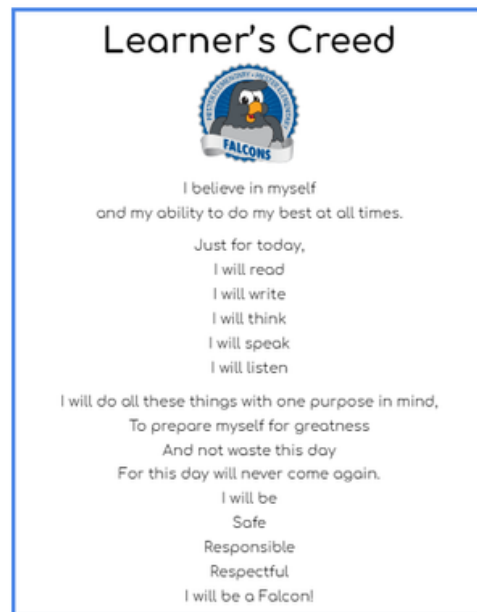
Math: Students will be at or above grade level in Mathematics by 1st grade
