JOB DESCRIPTION

General Description:

The school psychologist, under the direct supervision of the Director of Special Education/District Psychologist with the school site administrators, provides psychological and counseling services, including, but not limited to, testing and consultation services with students, parent and staff. The psychologist shall also assist the Director of Special Education in all matters related to serving special education students.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Provides psychological and counseling services to students referred by school staff
- 2. Administers individual intelligence and achievement tests to students for educational planning purposes
- 3. Prepares reports and makes recommendations for special class placement to the individual education program team for special education students
- 4. Serves as a member of the individual education program team for the admission and discharge of special education students
- 5. Assists the Director of Special Education in all matters related to the special education program
- 6. Assists in the coordination of services of auxiliary personnel, such as the Speech Therapist, etc.
- 7. Serves as a member of the districts advisory committee and the school advisory committees, school pupil personnel committees, etc.
- 8. Assists with counseling and testing functions in programs
- 9. Works closely with outside agencies in serving the psychological needs of students
- 10. Performs other duties as assigned by immediate supervisor
