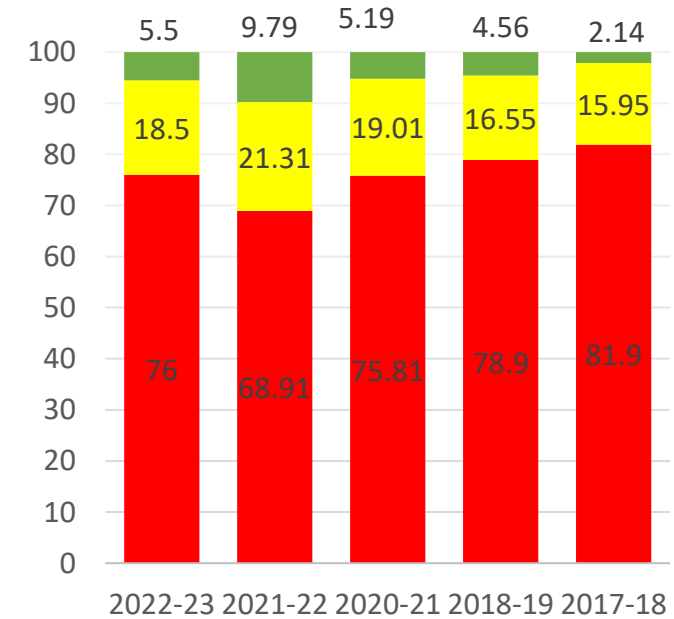

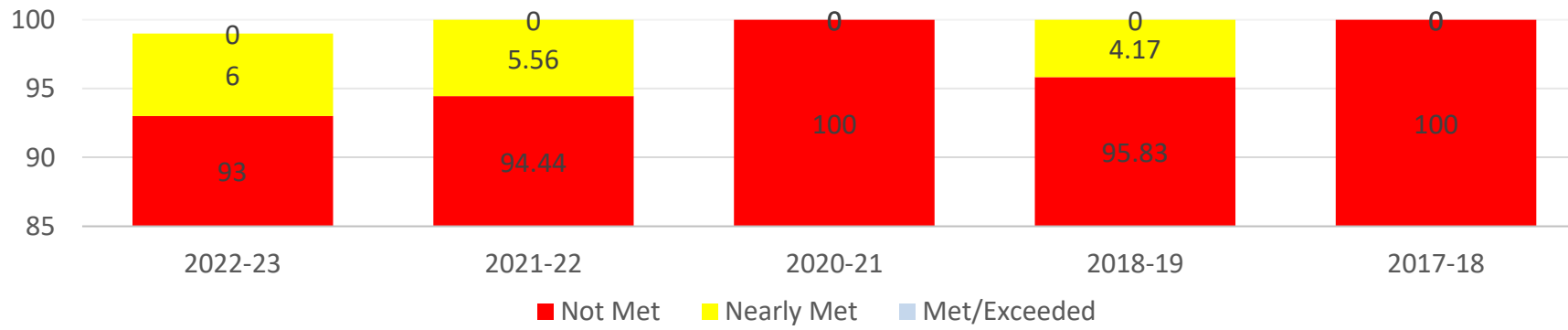

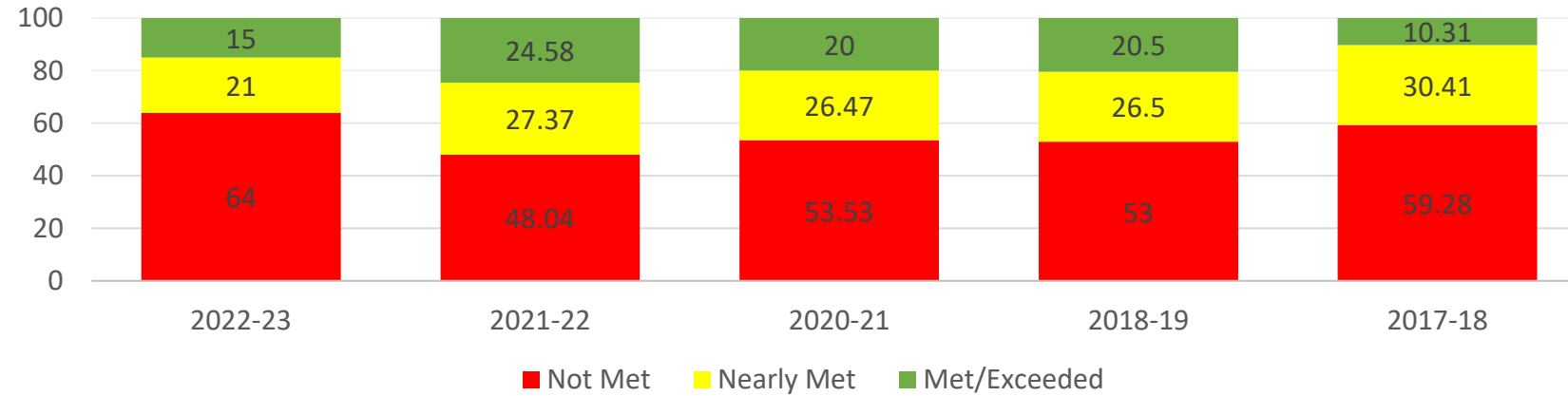

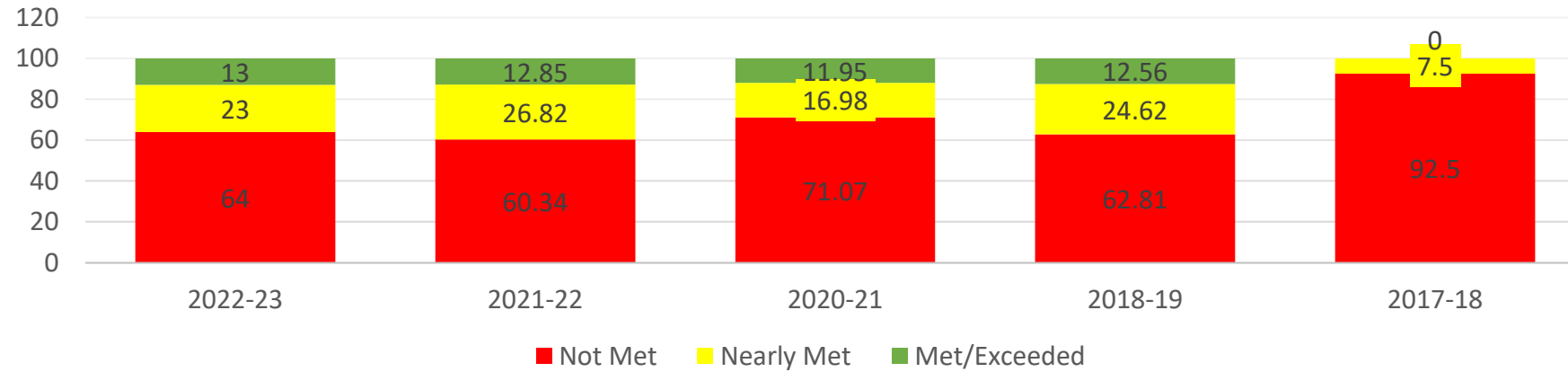

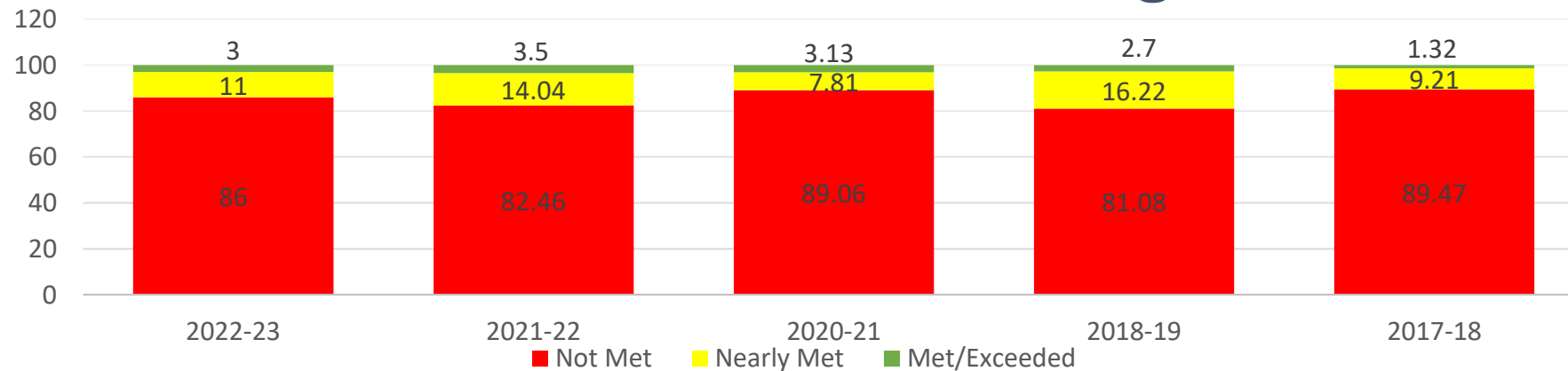

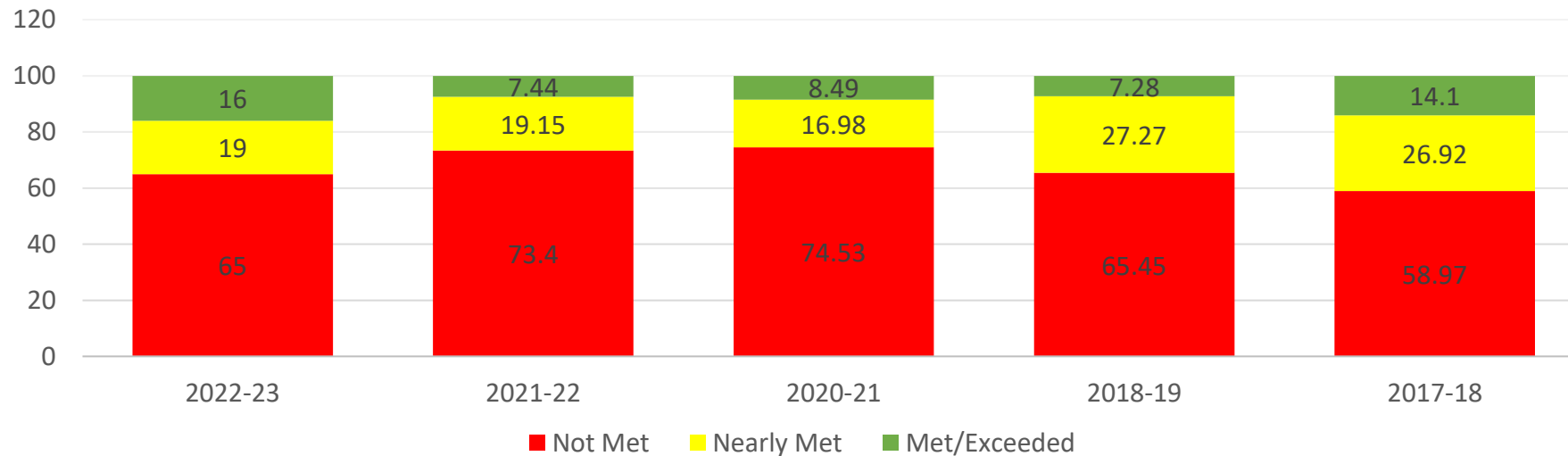

# NOW WHAT

## **Data Driven actions initiated by site level data**

- Disciplined Action
  - Built to Suit (Intervention/Acceleration)
  - Stick to the Program
