Bids shall be submitted at the District Office by the date and time listed above. Any bids received after the time specified above or after any extensions due to material changes shall be returned unopened.

There will be a job walk on July 26, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at the Classroom "400" building (check in at the High School office). The address of Farmersville High School is 631 E. Walnut Avenue, Farmersville, CA 93223. Potential bidders are encouraged to attend the job walk to better understand the facility and area of installation.

Firms submitting a bid must possess a valid and active Class C-11 License at the time of bid submission and throughout the duration of the contract. The Contractor's California State License number shall be clearly stated in the proposing firm's proposal.

Prevailing wages are applicable to all work. These per diem rates, including holiday and overtime work, as well as employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, and similar purposes, are available from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations. Pursuant to California Labor Code Sections 1720 *et seq.*, it shall be mandatory upon the contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under such contractor, to pay not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in the Labor Code, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.
