Dear Farmersville Unified School District Parent,

We want to provide parents with updated information regarding COVID-19 cases. Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency has reported an increase of + 51.1% of new COVID-19 cases across the county as of August 8, 2021. The district is taking all the necessary precautions to ensure that students and staff are in a safe learning environment as outlined in our FUSD COVID-19 Safety Plan approved by the California Department of Public Health (please see attached)

Students are pre-screened daily by staff for COVID-19 symptoms. We are requesting that parents also assist and prescreen students for COVID-19 symptoms daily before sending them to school. Please do not send students to school who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms which include the following:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

The district is taking all the necessary COVID-19 precautionary measures to identify and quarantine any student who may have been exposed to COVID-19. We have attached the updated California Department of Public Health modified quarantine procedures for your review. Students who are quarantined, may continue to receive virtual classroom instruction by logging into the teacher's Google Classroom.
