# JOB TITLE: COMPUTER/NETWORK TECHNICIAN

# JOB DESCRIPTION

## **Definition:**

Under the general direction of the Network Manager, performs a variety of technical duties related to the installation, operation, repair and support of the district instructional and management technologies

## Examples of Essential Duties:

### MAINTENANCE

- Diagnose, troubleshoot and resolve stand-alone and network hardware, software and telecommunications problems
- Provide on-site support as necessary to maintain efficient operations throughout the District
- Develop and maintain a regular equipment cleaning and maintenance schedule for all technology inventory

## STAND ALONE COMPUTERS/NETWORK SYSTEMS

- · Install, configure and maintain stand alone computers and application software
- Install, configure and maintain local and wide area network equipment including file servers, workstations, hubs, routers, concentrators, switches, hard drives, printers, application and system hardware, CD-ROMs, tape drives and cabling at school sites and District Office
- Assist in the collection and analysis of local and wide area network performance data to ensure secure and efficient operation
- Work with telecommunications service providers in the installation and maintenance of data phone services and related communications devices
- Support installation of fiber optic backbone cable and other infrastructure in classrooms, libraries and laboratories

TRAINING

- Assist in the development and implementation of a comprehensive training program in the use
   of technology
- Coordinate software distribution and provide instruction regarding its use, maintenance and license agreements
- Provide training to staff and students to ensure proper use of hardware and software, including troubleshooting of minor system setup and repair problems

### OTHER

- Assist in the development and revision of the District and site technology plans
- Assist in the development of the District's application to the Schools and Libraries Discount program and other grant programs.
- Assist in the development and review of bid specifications and other pertinent documents related to computer and network operations

# Qualifications:

Knowledge of:

- Computer technology and software systems, application programs, data communication networks
- Methods, procedures, materials and techniques used in the installation and maintenance of computer and computer systems
- Training end users to effectively use existing and new technologies
- School district application programs such as Eagle/Aeries, cafeteria point of sale, terminal emulation programs highly desirable

Ability To:

- Operate standard office equipment, operate various computer applications software, test and troubleshoot hardware/software problems
- Use English in both written and verbal form. Knowledge of Spanish is desirable
- Maintain effective and professional relationships with administrators, staff, students, vendors and outside agencies
- Work independently with minimal supervision
- Stand and walk for prolonged periods of time
- Lift and carry objects weighing up to 50 pounds
- Sit, stand, walk, bend, stoop, kneel, perform grasping and handling motions and torso
  rotations on a continuous basis; adequate sight or corrected vision for the purpose of
  reading instructions and printed or written material; hear and speak to communicate to coworkers, students and the public; dexterity of the hands and fingers to operate computer
  equipment

### Education:

High School diploma or equivalent. Preference will be given to those with college courses in computer science or related fields. AA Degree in computer science is highly desirable.

At least two years of related experience in a school district, in business setting or the military.
