Testing Schedule for English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)

Students in transitional kindergarten through grade twelve who are classified as **English Learners** will take the Summative ELPAC every year until they are reclassified as proficient in English. Students are tested on their skills in Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing.

Hester:

TK- First grade students will be tested one on one. The testing takes approximately one hour per student. Appointments will be scheduled individually.

Testing will begin February 16, 2021- March 25, 2021

Snowden:

Second grade students will be tested one on one. The testing takes approximately one hour per student. Appointments will be scheduled individually.

Reading, Writing and Listening domain- February 22, 2021 @ 9:30-12:00 at your child's school.

Speaking domain (one on one) 30 minutes: February 23, 2021-March 19, 2021
