Department of State Architect (DSA) has deemed the canopy a student work room/area that would require fire sprinklers on the canopy. The roll up doors on the vocational educational building will now require fire rated doors. Mr. Navarro

recommended the Board deny Change Order No. 3 and direct the District to seek other alternatives.
