On a motion by Trustee Lopez and seconded by Trustee Reyes and carried: (Ayes: Mason, Vanderslice, Lopez, Reyes; Noes: None; Absent: Vasquez), the expelled Student #EXP-02-11-13-12 for violation of Education Code 48915(a) 1 Causing serious physical injury to another person, except in self-defense; 48915(a)5 Assault or battery upon an school employee, as defined in PC240 & 242; and of the District's Student Discipline Code 48900A(2) Willfully used force or violence upon the other person, except in self-defense; 48900R Engaged in an act of bullying, and 48900K Disrupted school activities or otherwise willfully defied the valid authority of supervisors, teachers, administrators, school officials, or other school personnel engaged in the performance of their duties. The student was expelled for this semester and the following semester; referred to the County Community School; ordered to seek counseling and provide written evidence to the District that counseling was received and satisfactorily completed. The student will perform 20 hours of community service at the discretion of the supervisor. A copy of the expulsion letter will be sent to the District Attorney, Probation Department, and/or Police Department (for acts of assault, possession or sale of alcohol/narcotics/controlled substances, or possession of weapons or firearms). The student was ordered to stay away from all school campuses other than on school business as directed by the school including after school, evening, and weekend activities. The student must apply for readmission after July 1, 2013.
